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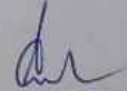

- # Awareness Programme on Women Education and Deforestation.



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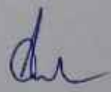

- * The well known certificate invited for such events.



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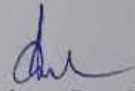

- * If any financial requirement arises the cell forward this to the principal.



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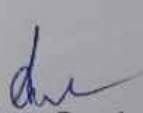
