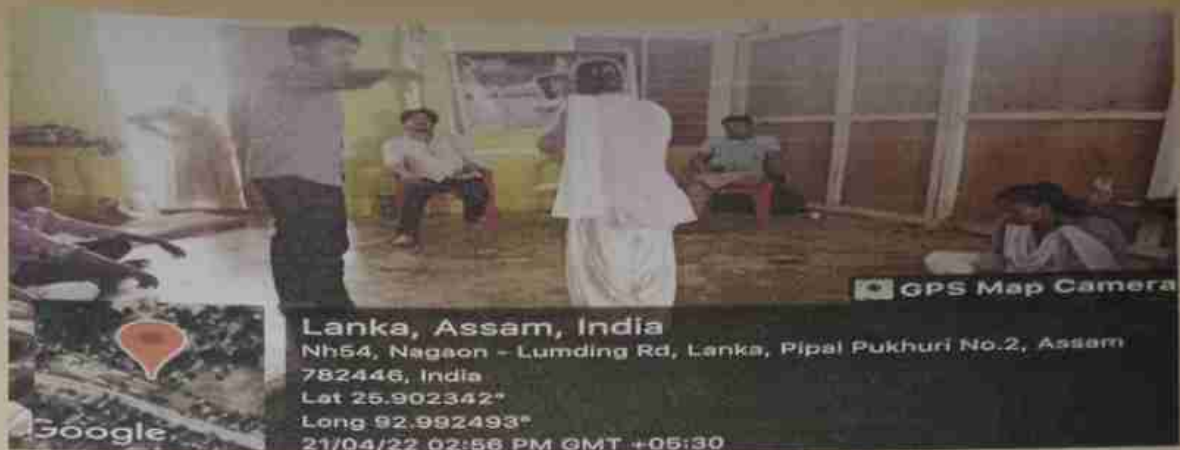


REPORT:

Report on an Educational Tour to Kaziranga



On 07/01/2022, Udali College organized an educational tour to Kaziranga National Orchid and Biodiversity Park from the college campus, jointly organized by the Assamese and Economics departments. A good number of students and teachers gathered at the campus at 5:30 a.m. For the journey, a star bus was hired by the college authority. There were 30 students from the 5th semester and two assistant professors from each department, along with the principal, who got on the bus and the journey started around 6 a.m. We reached Kaziranga at 11 a.m. On the way students were provided breakfast at 9 a.m.

Kaziranga Orchid Park is located 2 km from the central range of Kaziranga, Kohora Chariali. The park is sprawling in the Durgapur Village. The Kaziranga Orchid Park has around 600 varieties of wild orchids, which have been collected from across the northeastern region. In addition, the park also houses a rich museum, a medicinal plant garden, a product outlet center, a garden for native flowers and fruits, a fishery for native fish, and a cactus species display room. The forest also has various native varieties of bamboo and cane.

After reaching there, the particular guides of the Orchid Park made them understand every object in the park. Rashna Boruah and Dr. Abdul Wadud, both assistant professors of Economics, explained the importance of educational tours, including giving students the chance to build closer bonds with their classmates, experience new environments, and enjoy a day away from the classroom. They also discussed the main aim of the tour, which was to provide as much knowledge about different orchids and their value in our biodiversity. Sumi Rani Das and Junali Laskar, both assistant professors of Assamese, took care of the students and provided whatever they needed. After visiting the park, lunch was offered in the park, which is called "Assamese traditional thali." We returned around 5:00 p.m. and reached the college around 8:30 p.m., and the students were dropped off at their homes.

Date:02-05-2022



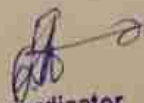

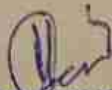

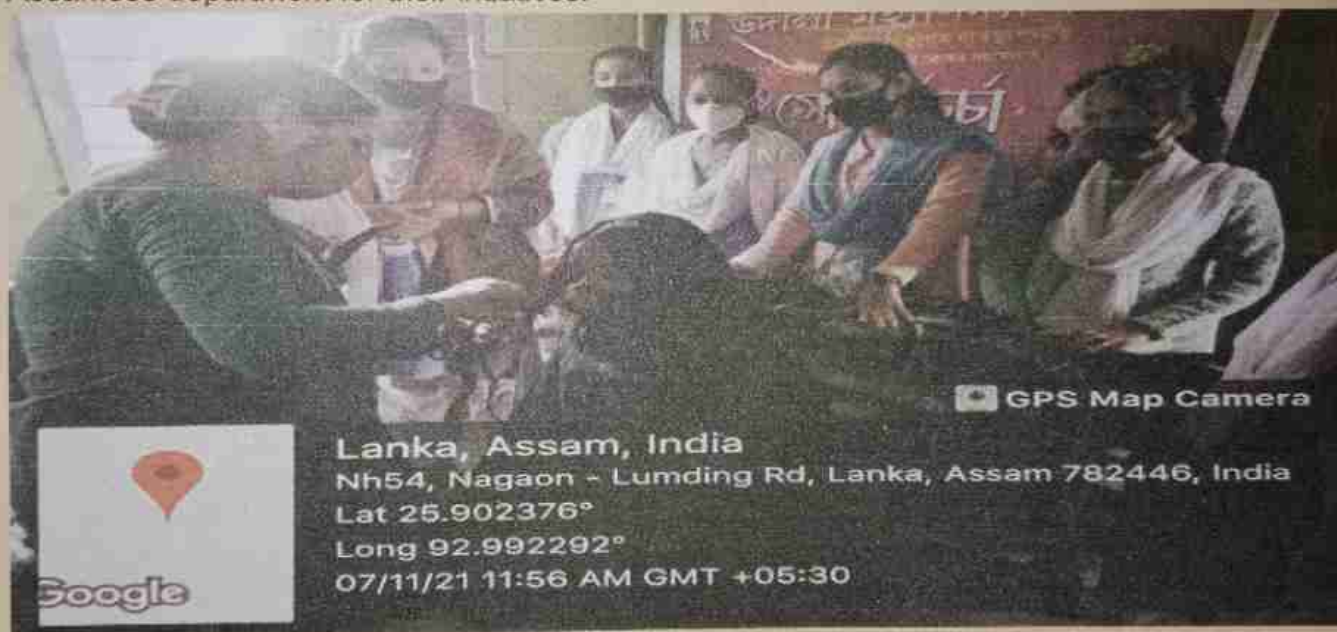
A Certificate Course

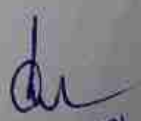

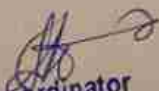

"Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav" and "Har Ghar Tiranga", 15th August, 2022.

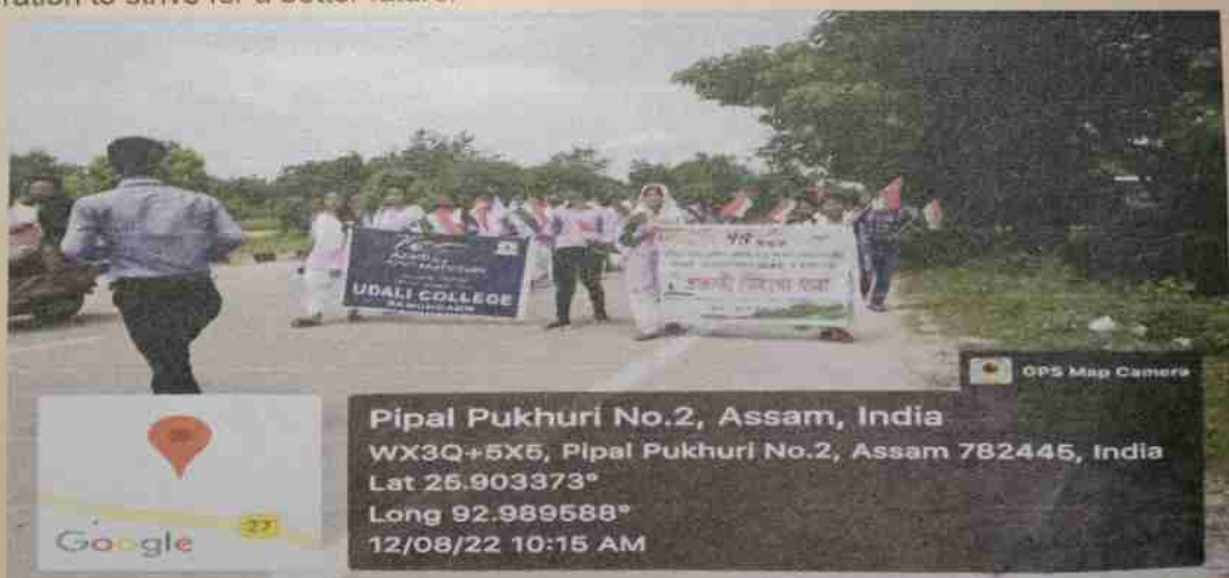

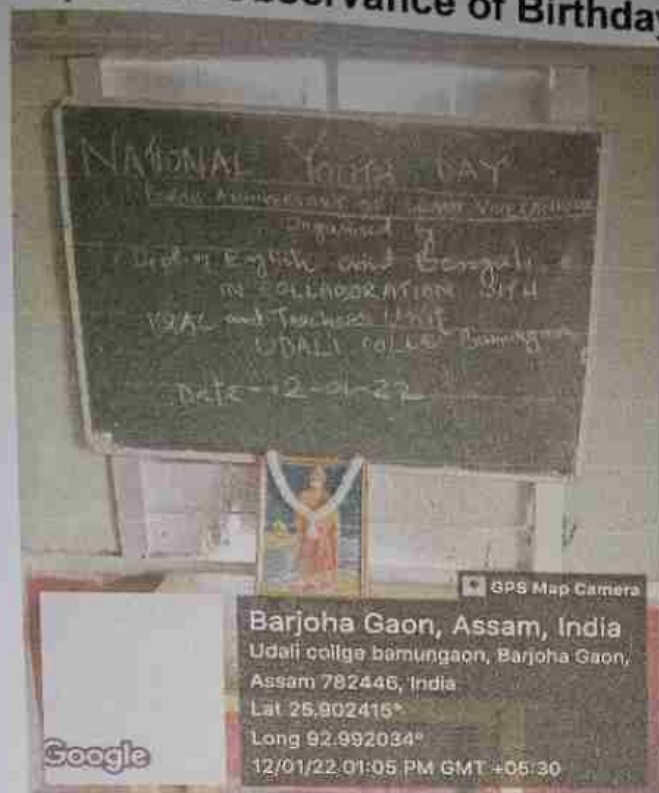

International Human Rights day Celebrations.

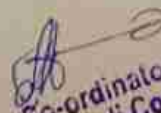

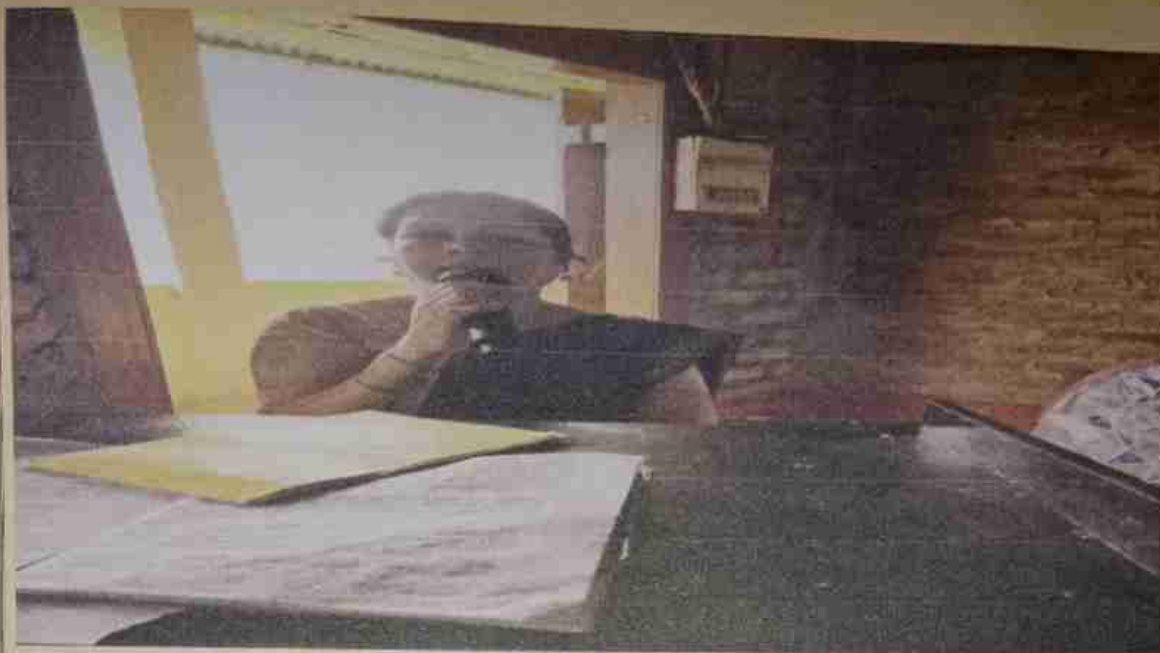

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Devasree Sharma, Asstt Professor, Geography delivering speech

Again an outstanding speech also delivered by a faculty member Devasree Sharma, Geography on the topic of the effects of CARBONDI-OXIDE ,GREENHOUSE EFFECTS and CLIMATE CHANGING and discussing the issues related to Environment with audiences and also trying to make them aware about the upcoming devastating situations of Environment. She also described the causes and consequences of Greenhouse effect saying that Carbon dioxide is one of the examples of heat-trapping gases, including methane, nitrous oxide and water vapor and in balanced proportions, these gases act as a blanket that keeps the earth's surface warm. She also said "But at elevated levels, especially of carbon dioxide, it accumulates in the atmosphere, becoming a thick blanket, trapping radiation and heat energy from the sun;It overheats the earth as less heat energy escapes into space;This effect of elevated carbon dioxide levels in the atmosphere affects the environment by melting ice caps, thereby increasing ocean water levels resulting in the loss of coastal wetlands and shoreline.Elevated levels of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere cause it to dissolve in water vapor and form carbonic acid. Which is rained down as acid rain. Acid rain causes some physical damage to plants and pollutes both soil and water. And all these are responsible for CLIMATE CHANGES. ".At the end she also said that if we don't aware of all these things the future generations will face terrible situations and also suggests some ways to protect the Biodiversity and the environment.

Report on Domestic Animal Vaccination Adopted Village, May 29, 2022



On May 29, 2022, a domestic animal vaccination campaign was conducted in the adopted village Goshagaon Manipuri Basti, organized by IQAC, Udali College, Bamungaon. The purpose of this campaign was to ensure the health and well-being of the animals in the village by providing them with necessary vaccinations and medication.
