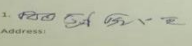
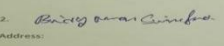
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Agreement with Adopted Village “Gosaigaon Manipuri Basti”

Implementation of Village Adoption Programme 1st Party: Udali College, Bamungaon, Lanka, Nagaon, Assam, Pin-782446 2nd Party: Gosaigaon Manipuri Basti, Gosaigaon, Lanka, Nagaon, Assam, Pin-782446 The Background Uttam Bharat Abhiyan was launched under the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) with an aim to connect institution of higher education with local communities to address the development challenges through appropriate techniques. The village adoption involves moving from idea to action there is critical monitoring of the self and others—in terms of development principles, development ethics and prevailing local practice and betterment in the condition of living of the people we are working with. Udali College, Bamungaon adopted the village, Gosaigaon Manipuri Basti in 2017 following the directions of Human Resource and Development (MHRD). About Gosaigaon Manipuri Basti :- According to Census 2011 information the location code or village code of Gosaigaon Manipuri Basti is 285402. Gosaigaon Manipuri Basti village is located in Lanka subdivision of Nagaon district in Assam, India. It is situated 9km away from sub-district headquarter Lanka (tehsildar office) and 70km away from district headquarter Nagaon. As per 2009 stats, Bamungaon is the gram panchayat of Gosaigaon Manipuri Basti village. The total geographical area of village is 101.17 hectares. Gosaigaon Manipuri Basti has a total population of 232 peoples, out of which male population is 119 while female population is 113. Literacy rate of Gosaigaon Manipuri Basti village is 75.86% out of which 79.83% males and 71.68% females are literate. There are about 48 houses in Gosaigaon Manipuri Basti village. Pincode of Gosaigaon Manipuri Basti village is 782446. Why Udali College Adopted Gosaigaon Manipuri Basti Gosaigaon Manipuri Basti is approximately 5 km away from Udali College, Bamungaon. Most of the students belong to this area get enrolled in this college. Towards implementing the village adoption programmes the students of this area raised their voice demanding the village as an adopted village. According to them the most of the people of the village are not aware of the present policies and technologies. Udali College, Bamungaon adopted this Gosaigaon Manipuri Basti to render service by creating and sustaining a culture of cooperating living for inclusive and sustainable development and to empower marginalized and vulnerable groups in the village particularly the aged, women, youth and the children of the community.
