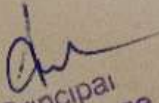
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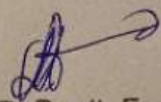
HANDLOOM(A KEY TO WOMEN EMPOWERMENT)

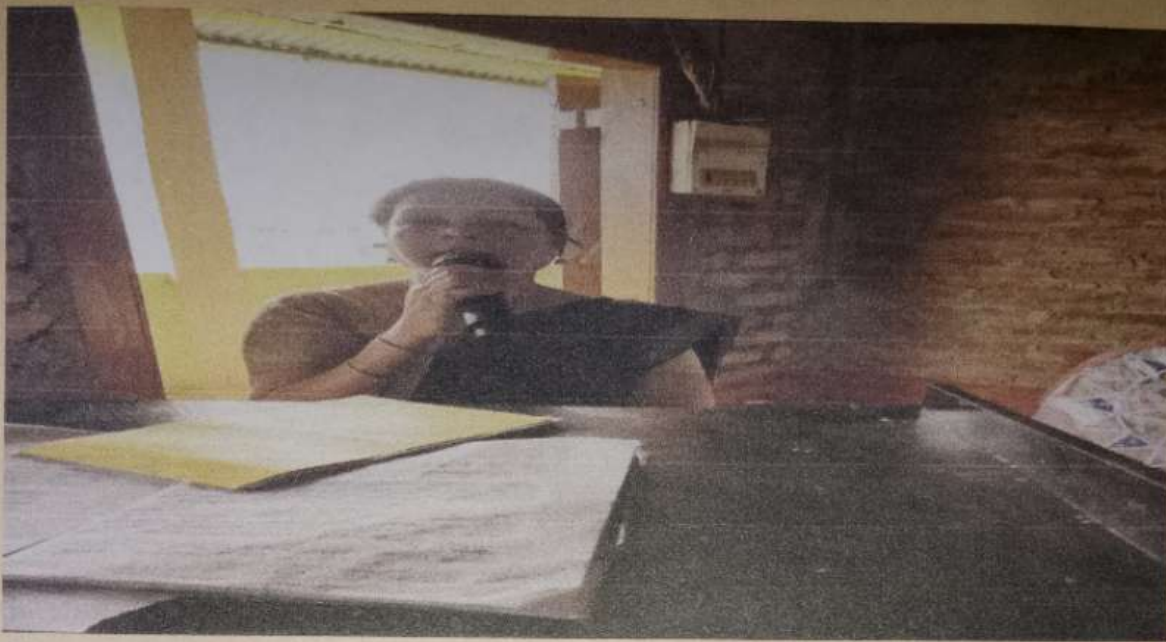
The Guest answering and advising the students

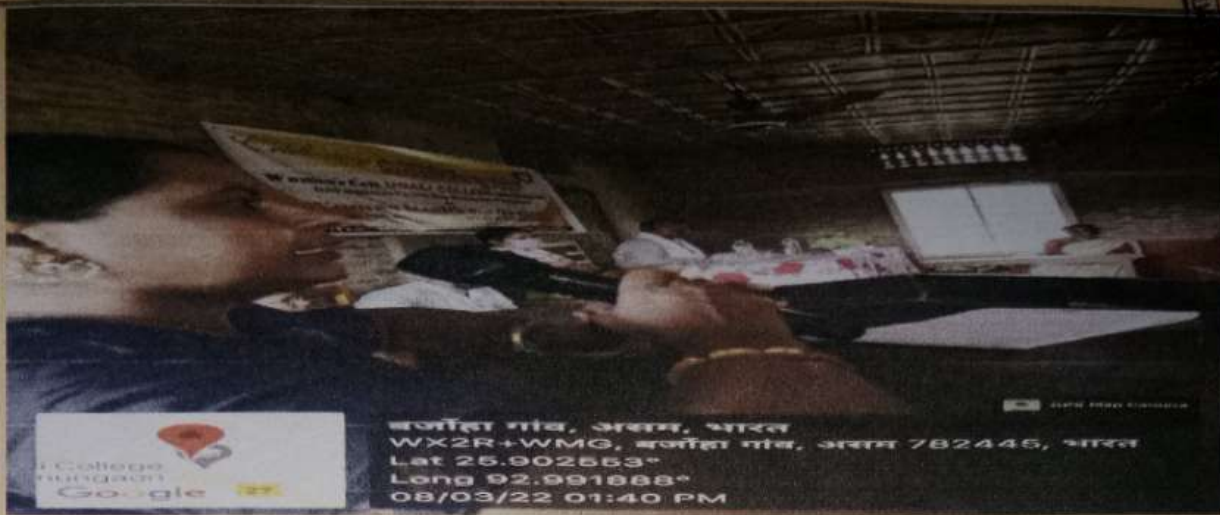
