CURRICULUM CREDIT SYSTEM**Rabindranath Tagore University: Four Year Under Graduate Programme****(Based on UGC Curriculum and Credit Framework)**

The Rabindranath Tagore University has adopted under graduate Course curriculum Framework (UGCF) under New Education Policy, 2020 to be implemented from August, 2023. It is a structure for four-year under Graduate programmes in different disciplines with multiple exit options.

Design of Courses:

The categories of courses and requirement of minimum credits for 4-year degree as per UGC are as follows:

1. Major (DSC)	: 80 Credits
2. Minor(DSE)	:32Credits
3. Multidisciplinary(GE)	:9 Credits
4. Ability Enhancement Course	:8 Credits
5. Skill Enhancement Course	:9 Credits
6. Value Added Course	:8 Credits
7. Summer Internship	:2 Credits
8. Dissertation/Research project	:12 Credits

ATTENDANCE

1. Students failing to attend a minimum of 75% classes in each subject will not be eligible to appear in final examination.

2. Continuous absence for 25 days in a class is enough to debar the concerned students from attending the class/from appearing in the examination.

3. Scholarship holders having less than 75% attendance may be deprived of the scholarship

GENERAL RULES

1. A Student who is found to violate college rules shall be liable to expulsion.
2. If a student's involvement in any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, such a student would be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, that student will be expelled from the college.
3. A student who is found to have indulged in consumption of drugs or intoxicating drinks, gambling and other immoral activities shall be liable to expulsion.
4. Attendance in UG classes is compulsory. To be eligible to sit for the Examination as a regular candidate, the students should have at least 75% of attendance of lecture.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE ISSUE AND RETURN OF LIBRARY BOOKS:

1. A student will be allowed to borrow maximum one book at a time.
2. A student will be issued book for a period of 15 days from the date of issue.
3. A student must return the book borrowed within 15 days.
4. A fine of Rs. 2/- will have to be paid by the borrower for each day of delay.

5. The book can be re-issued once it is returned. Provided there is no reservation of the same book by another persons

6. Marking or writing there in with ink or pencil, tearing off & taking out its pages or otherwise damaging will constitute an injury to a book

7. Any such injury the book is a serious offence

8. 4 book will be issued only to the student concerned and not to any one else.

9. The student must return all the books and obtain "No Que" from the library before filling up the forms of final exam.

REGULATIONS OF THE Four Year Under Graduate
(FYUGP) Programme Rabindranath Tagore University (RTU)

1. Four Year Under Graduate Programme (FYUGP)

The Four Year Under Graduate Programme is Multiple Entry and Exit system in every year becoming more learner-centric. A FYUGP offers the student a diversity of courses to choose from and the autonomy to decide the place, pace and time of learning. The UGC has recommended that it is desirable for all institutions of Higher Education in the country to move to a FYUGP and, together with it, implement a uniform grading system.

2. UNDER GRADUATE FYUGP (FYUGP) PROGRAMMES:

The undergraduate degree programme in the FYUGP will have courses spread across eight semesters. A typical semester will comprise a minimum of 15 to 15 weeks of academic work that will translate into 90 actual teaching days. Two consecutive (one odd and one even) semesters will make up an academic year. An UG course shall be of Eight Semesters covering three Calendar Years (Academic, Sessions June to May). The duration of the Odd Semesters (First, Third, Fifth, and Seventh) shall be June to November, and that of Even Semesters (Second, Fourth, Sixth, and Eighth) shall be December to May.

The dates and duration mentioned in the academic calendar concerned will be in consonance with the above schedule as far as practicable.

Each student must take admission in three consecutive Academic Sessions starting with the first semester. Students who do not enroll in the Second Academic Session will not be eligible to take admission in the Third Academic Session

The minimum time requirement to acquire an undergraduate degree will be three years. The maximum time allowed to complete the programme will be six years.

Udali College is delighted to announce its enthusiastic adoption of the Four Year Under Graduate Programme (FYUGP) commencing from the academic session of 2023-24. It will be implementing in alignment with the guidelines laid out by Gauhati University, UGC, and the government's directives regarding the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

This new initiative reflects our commitment to providing students with a comprehensive and immersive learning experience, promoting interdisciplinary studies, skill development, and research-oriented-education. By embracing the FYUGP, Udali College aims to empower students to become well-rounded individuals equipped with the knowledge, skills, and competencies necessary for their future endeavors.

The key features of GU-FYUGP (Four Year Under Graduate Programme) are as follows:

Duration: GU-FYUGP is a four-year honors or research programme. However, students also have the option to pursue a three-year degree programme with a major or without a major.

Programme offered: GU-FYUGP offers various undergraduate programmes, including Bachelor of Arts (BA). These programmes provide comprehensive education in their respective disciplines.

Research focus: The programme emphasizes research-oriented learning, allowing students to develop critical-thinking, analytical skills, and in-depth knowledge in their chosen fields of study.

Under the RTU-FYUGP (Rabinranath Tagore University Four Year degree Graduate Programme) at Udali College, these are the following initiatives that Udali College is implementing in line with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

Multiple Exit and Entry Points:

Under the undergraduate program at Rabinranath Tagore University, multiple exit and entry points are allowed at specific stages of the program. As per the NEP 2020, students have the action to exit the program and receive appropriate certifications after completing the 1ST, 5th, and 7th semesters. This provision offers flexibility to students who may choose to enter the workforce or pursue further studies after completing a certain number of semester. By allowing multiple exit points, Rabindranath Tagore University promotes inclusive and recognizes diverse career trajectories for its students.

Certificate, Diploma and Degree

Rabindranath Tagore University Four-Year undergraduate program, following the guidelines of the NEP 2020, offers different certifications based on the stage of exit for students.

Certificate: If a student chooses to exit the program after completing one year. They will receive a Certificate. This certification acknowledges their successful completion of one year of undergraduate studies.

Diploma: if a student decides to exit the program after completing two years, they will be awarded a Diploma,

This certification signifies their completion of two years of undergraduate studies and indicate higher level of proficiency in the chosen field.

Degree with Major/Without Major: If a student completes three years of the program and decides to exit, they will be conferred a Degree in a Stream with or without Major ,This degree recognizes their completion of the full three year undergraduate program and signifies their expertise their chosen field of study.

Degree with Honours/Research: For students when fully completed the entire four year undergraduate program Rabindranath Tagore University awards Degree with Honors Research, This degree recognizes their comprehensive education and signifies the ascendance then chosen due as well as then potential for research for higher studies.

The Rabinranath Tagore University accommodate the diverse aspirations and career paths of students. allowing them to receive recognition for their the academic accomplishments at different stages of their updergraduate journey.

Progression: Rabindranath Tagore University's three year degree program wants to admission in the MA as per program. On the other hand, the four year degree program allows students to directly enter the MA 2nd Year program for pursue a Ph.D, subject to certain conditions and eligibility criteria.

Double Major: Rabindranath Tagore University offers students the option to pursue a double major blended mode. This allows them to earn 12 free credits through offline courses and 36 credits through online course from MOOC (Massive Open Online Courses). By opting for a double major, students can gain expertise in two different disciplines and enhance their career prospects.

Course Structure and Credits: The undergraduate program at Rabindranath Tagore University, RTU-FYUGP, complete of two main parts Core Courses and Common Courses in a three-year degree program with or without a major, a minimum of 84 credits is allocated for Core Courses and 36 credits for Common Courses in a four year degree program, 120 credits are assigned for Core Courses and 40 credits are allocated for Common Courses. The detailed list of Core and Common courses, along with the credits assigned to each, can be found in the provided Programmes Offered column.

ABC : Rabindranath Tagore University is registered in the Academic Bank of Credit (ABC), which virtual academic mechanism facilitating the mobility of students within and between Higher Educational institutions across the country. As a result, all students of College come under the purview of the ABC At the end of each examination in GU-FYUGP, the university deposits all earned credits into the ABC for such

student to participate in this system, students must obtain an ABC ID through the Digilocker platform before admission.

Admission: Prior to admission, students must first obtain an ABC ID. Once they have their ABC ID, they can proceed with the online admission process through the college's website (www.udalicollege.co.in) Detailed information regarding the admission procedure can be found on the college's website, providing students with clear guidelines for successfully completing the admission process.
